Slide 2: Introduction

Title: What is the Indian Independence Movement?

Text:

- India was ruled by the British for a long time, over 200 years.
- Indian people wanted freedom from British rule.
- The movement to make India free is called the **Indian Independence Movement**.
- This movement ended in 1947 when India became free.

Slide 3: Early Resistance to British Rule

Title: The First War for Freedom

Text:

- In **1857**, Indian soldiers and people fought against the British. This is called the **First War of Independence** or **Sepoy Mutiny**.
- It was the first big fight for freedom, but it did not succeed.
- Leaders like **Rani Lakshmbai, Mangal Pandey**, and others fought bravely.

Slide 4: Mahatma Gandhi and Peaceful Protest

Title: Gandhi's Peaceful Fight

Text:

- **Mahatma Gandhi** became the leader of the movement in the 1920s.

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- He believed in **non-violence** (ahimsa), meaning no fighting, only peaceful protest.
- Gandhi told people not to buy British goods and not to work for the British.
- This was called the **Non-Cooperation Movement**. It was a peaceful way to resist British rule.

Slide 5: Important Events

Title: Big Events in the Freedom Fight

Text:

- **Salt March (1930):** Gandhi and others walked 240 miles to make salt as a protest against British taxes on salt.
- **Quit India Movement (1942):** Indians asked the British to "Quit" or leave India.
- These events helped to bring people together in the fight for freedom.

Slide 6: India Becomes Free

Title: India's Freedom in 1947

Text:

- After many years of struggle, India finally got freedom on **August 15, 1947**.
- **Jawaharlal Nehru** became India's first Prime Minister.
- India and Pakistan became two separate countries.
