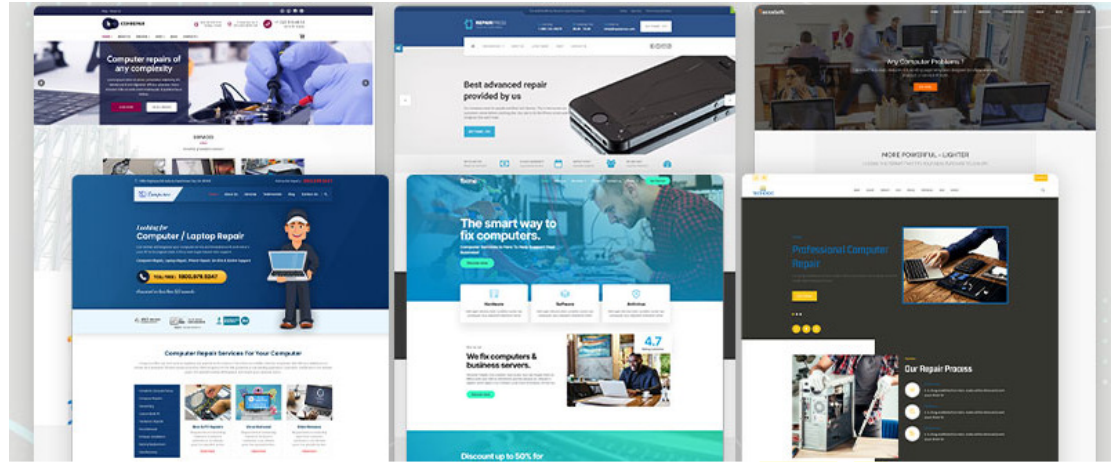

1. Create a New Document

- Open Adobe InDesign → File > New > Document.
- Set page size (e.g., A4 or Web 1366x768 if designing for digital).
- Set margins and columns for alignment.

2. Set Up Layout

- Use the **Rectangle Frame Tool (F)** to create placeholder boxes for images (like laptops, people, repair tools).
- Use the **Type Tool (T)** to create text boxes for headings, subheadings, and paragraphs.
- Arrange sections similar to the website templates shown (header, main body, footer).

3. Insert Images

- Go to File > Place → select images (like computer repair, laptops, technicians).
- Fit images using **Object > Fitting > Fill Frame Proportionally**.

4. Add Headings & Buttons

- Use bold fonts for headings (e.g., “Computer & Laptop Repair”).
- Draw button shapes with the **Rectangle Tool (M)**, fill with color, and add text like “Book Now”.

5. Apply Styles

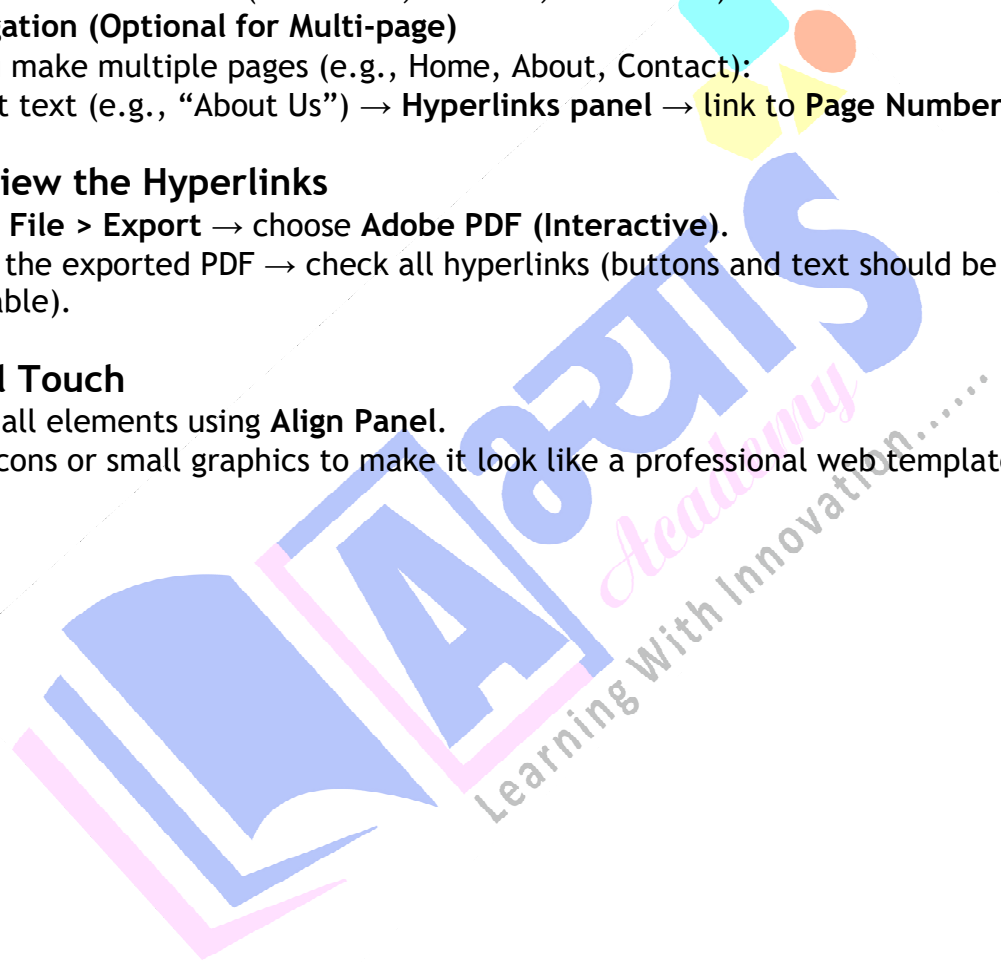
- Use Paragraph Styles for headings, subheadings, and body text.

Hyperlinks and Interactive Features

- Use Color Swatches to keep the design consistent (blue, white, and grey tones, like in the sample).
- 6. Add Hyperlinks**
- Select the text or button you want to make clickable (e.g., "Book Now").
 - Go to **Window > Interactive > Hyperlinks**.
 - In the panel, click **New Hyperlink**.
 - Enter the URL (e.g., www.repairservice.com).
 - Choose **Appearance: Invisible Rectangle** (or visible if you want underline).
 - Repeat for all buttons (like Home, Services, Contact Us).
 - **Navigation (Optional for Multi-page)**
 - If you make multiple pages (e.g., Home, About, Contact):
 - Select text (e.g., "About Us") → **Hyperlinks panel** → link to **Page Number**.
- 7. Preview the Hyperlinks**
- Go to **File > Export** → choose **Adobe PDF (Interactive)**.
 - Open the exported PDF → check all hyperlinks (buttons and text should be clickable).
- 8. Final Touch**
- Align all elements using **Align Panel**.
 - Add icons or small graphics to make it look like a professional web template.
