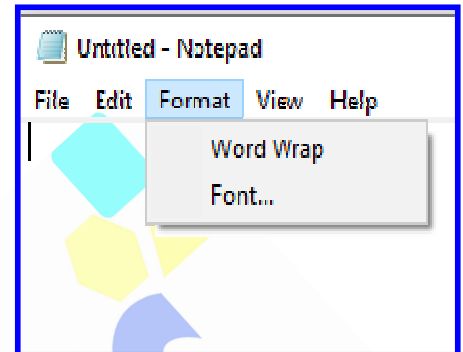

Importance of Format Menu in Notepad

The Format Menu in Notepad is used to make adjustments to how the text is displayed or arranged within the Notepad window. Even though Notepad is a basic text editor with limited features, the Format Menu provides a few useful tools to enhance your editing experience.

Font Menu - Word Wrap in Notepad

• **Why We Use It:**

When writing or editing text, long lines can become hard to read if they extend beyond the window and require horizontal scrolling. Word Wrap ensures that the text stays within the visible window area by automatically wrapping long lines to the next line.

• **Use Case:**

If you're writing a paragraph or working with a long document, turning on Word Wrap will make reading and editing much easier. Without it, you would need to scroll horizontally to read long lines of text, which can be inconvenient.

• **Example:**

If you're writing a long note and want it to fit neatly within the window, enabling Word Wrap will allow the text to adjust to the window's size, keeping everything visible without scrolling.

Key Aspects of Font Menu:

Font Family:

A font family is a group of related fonts that share similar characteristics, but vary in style or weight. For example, Arial is a font family that includes different variations like Arial Regular, Arial Bold, and Arial Italic.

Some common font families include Times New Roman, Arial, Verdana, and Courier New.

Default Font Characteristics in Notepad:

- **Font:** Courier New
- **Font Size:** 10pt
- **Style:** Regular (not bold or italicized)

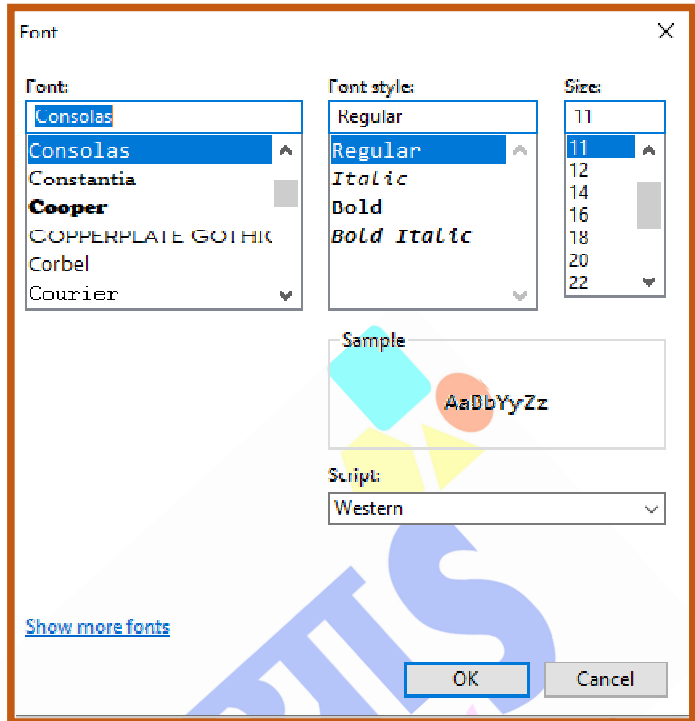
Font Style:

Font Style refers to the variations of a font family, such as:

- **Regular:** The standard version of the font.
- **Bold:** Makes the text thicker, often used for emphasis.
- **Italic:** Slants the text to the right, used for emphasis or to indicate titles or foreign words.
- **Underline:** Adds a line below the text.

Font Size:

Font Size defines the height of the characters. It is usually measured in points (pt) in print or pixels (px) on digital screens. For example, a 12-point font is commonly used for general text in documents.
