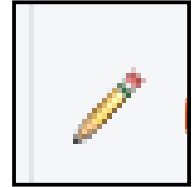

Module 2 - Drawing and Design Tools in Paint

Drawing and design tools in Microsoft Paint and how you use them:

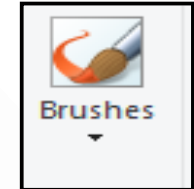
1. Pencil Tool

- This lets you draw freehand lines and sketches.
- Think of it like a regular pencil on paper.
- You can draw thin lines, perfect for simple outlines.



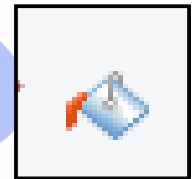
2. Brushes

- Paint offers different types of brushes like airbrush, calligraphy, or oil brush.
- These brushes let you paint with different textures and thicknesses.
- Good for coloring or creating a more artistic effect.



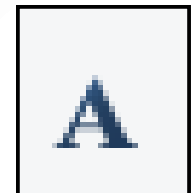
3. Fill Tool (Bucket)

- Use this tool to fill a closed area with one solid color. For example, if you draw a circle, you can fill the inside of the circle with red or blue.
- Make sure the shape is fully closed, or the color will spill outside.



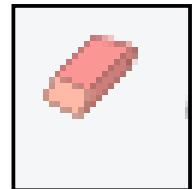
4. Text Tool

- Allows you to add text anywhere on your image.
- You can change the font, size, and color of the text.
- Useful for adding labels, titles, or captions.



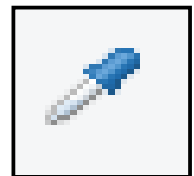
5. Eraser Tool

- Erases parts of your drawing or painting.
- It works like a real eraser, removing pixels.
- You can adjust the size of the eraser to erase big or small areas.



6. Color Picker

- This tool lets you click on any color in your image to select it as your active color.
- Handy when you want to use the exact same color again.

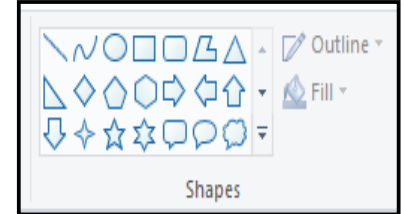

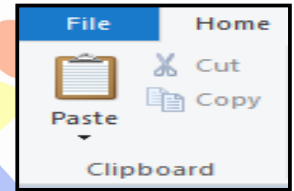
7. Shapes Tool

- You can draw basic shapes like rectangles, circles (ellipses), lines, arrows, and stars.
- Shapes can have an outline color and a fill color.
- You can resize and move shapes after drawing them.



8. Select Tool

- Lets you select part of your image.
- After selecting, you can move, copy, cut, or delete that part.
- Two types: rectangular selection (box shape) or free-form (any shape).



9. Resize & Skew

- Allows you to change the size of your entire image or selected part.
- Skew changes the angle, making the image look slanted.



10. Undo/Redo

- Undo lets you cancel your last action if you make a mistake.
- Redo reverses the undo if you change your mind.

How It All Works Together:

- You start by drawing shapes or freehand lines using the pencil, brush, or shapes.
- Use the fill bucket to add colors inside shapes.
- Add text for labels or messages.
- Use the select tool to move or edit parts of your drawing.
- Erase mistakes with the eraser.
- Adjust colors using the color picker.
- Finally, save your work as a file to share or edit later.
