Heading Tags and Paragraph Tag

In HTML, heading tags (<h1>, <h2>, <h3>, <h4>, <h5>, <h6>) are used to define headings or titles for sections of content. These tags create hierarchical structure within a webpage, with <h1> representing the highest level of heading and <h6> representing the lowest level.

Here's an overview of heading tags in HTML:

<h1>:

Represents the main heading or title of the webpage. Typically used once per webpage to denote the primary topic or subject. Should provide a clear and concise summary of the content.

Example:

```
<h1>Main Heading</h1>
```

<h2>:

Represents secondary headings within the webpage. Used to denote major sections or subsections of the content. Typically follows the <h1> tag and precedes lower-level headings.

Example:

```
<h2>Subheading</h2>
```

<h3>, <h4>, <h5>, <h6>:

Represent tertiary and lower-level headings within the webpage. Used for subsections or subtopics within major sections.

<h3> is the next level below <h2>, followed by <h4>, <h5>, and <h6>

Example:

```
<h3>Sub-subheading</h3>
```

Heading tags play a crucial role in organizing and structuring content within HTML documents.

They provide semantic meaning to the hierarchy of information, making it easier for both users and search engines to understand the relationship between different sections of the webpage.

It's important to use heading tags appropriately and maintain a logical hierarchy to ensure accessibility and usability.

The attribute to heading tag is **align attribute**.

- Align="left": will align the paragraph to the left of the screen
- Align="right": will align the paragraph to the right of the screen
- Align="center": will align the paragraph to the center of the screen.

Paragraph tag:

This tag is used to describe paragraph. The attribute to <p> tag is align attribute.

- Align="left": will align the paragraph to the left of the screen
- Align="right": will align the paragraph to the right of the screen
- Align="center": will align the paragraph to the center of the screen.

Pre tag:

• <pre> stands for **Preformatted Text**.

• It keeps the **spaces, tabs, and line breaks** exactly as you type them in your HTML code.

• Normally, HTML ignores extra spaces and line breaks, but <pre> preserves them.

• Use: Displaying code samples, poems, or any text where formatting must be preserved.

Example:

```
<pre>
Line 1      Line 2
Line 3
</pre>
```

OUTPUT:

With <pre> tag:

```
scss
```

```
Line 1      Line 2
```

```
Line 3
```

👉 Here, spaces and line breaks are kept exactly as typed.
