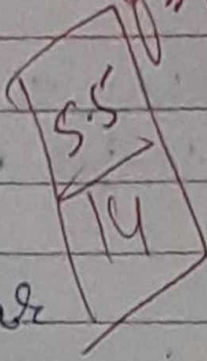

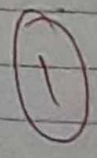

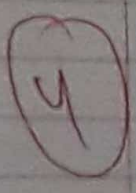

are responsible for storing data on a temporary or a permanent basis.

(i) Storage Capacity → It is to determine of the size of memory the capacity of internal memory or main memory can be expressed in terms of number of words or bytes.

(ii) Access Modes → A memory is comprised of various memory locations. The information from these memory location can be accessed randomly, sequentially and directly.
